



# KENTUCKY DERBY WINNER MYSTIK DAN BACK TO HIS BEST IN THE BLAME

First Derby Winner in 27 Years To Win a Race Back at Churchill

Since his upset victory in the GI Kentucky Derby nearly 400 days ago, not a whole lot had gone right for **Mystik Dan** (Goldencents). Yes, he was a meritorious second to a loose-on-the-lead Seize the Grey (Arrogate) in the GI Preakness Stakes, but he subsequently failed to shine in the GI Belmont Stakes, the GI Malibu Stakes when racing first off a 6 1/2-month absence and the GI Pegasus World Cup, defeating a total of four horses.

Trainer Ken McPeek has remained unflappable and unwavering in his belief that Mystik Dan still had more to give as an older horse, saying earlier this week that the colt had thrived back at Churchill Downs in the weeks following his bounce-back second to the classy Saudi Crown (Always Dreaming) in the Lake Ouachita Stakes at Oaklawn on the one-year anniversary of his Derby on May 3. McPeek's convictions, and those of jockey Brian Hernandez, Jr., were well and truly validated Saturday afternoon when Mystik Dan rolled through the final two furlongs to take the GIII Blame Stakes in a fashion more convincing than the 1 1/4-length margin of victory might suggest.

# NYSOS CANTERS HOME IN THE TRIPLE BEND

Opting for a confidence-builder over a trip to Saratoga for next weekend's GI Metropolitan Handicap, Baoma Corp's 'TDN Rising Star' Nysos (Nyquist) made light work of three rivals in Saturday's GIII Triple Bend Stakes at Santa Anita, strolling home under little encouragement from Juan Hernandez to score as a mile the best.

The slowest away from the inside stall, the prohibitive favorite methodically made his way through at the inside and poked his head in front as they raced in post-position order into the far turn. The comebacking **Dr. Venkman** (Ghostzapper), runner-up as the odds-on favorite in this event 12 months ago, tried his best to keep up, but Nysos began to assert at the quarter pole and was under no urging whatsoever while pulling clear from Dr. Venkman to take it by 5 1/2 lengths.

A smashing 10 1/2-length winner of his debut in October 2023 to become a no-brainer 'Rising Star', Nysos defeated future GI Santa Anita Derby winner Stronghold (Ghostzapper) in the GIII Bob Hope Stakes, cementing his status as a leading chance on the Triple Crown trail for 2024. Cont. p5



Off as the 3-1 third betting choice, Mystik Dan was content to take the sit from fourth while racing hard against the inside running rail as **Alexander Helios** (Cairo Prince) set a strong early pace in advance of **Antiquarian** (Preservationist) and a three-deep **'TDN Rising Star'** Hall of Fame (Gun Runner).

Ridden quietly through the middle furlongs while continuing to hug the fence, Mystik Dan was steered out and around Alexander Helios when that one hoisted the white flag at the five-sixteenths and was just as quickly back down onto the fence once heads were turned for home. Displaying a good kick when popped the question in earnest, Mystik Dan went on with things and proved clearly best in stakes-record time, as a resurgent Antiquarian and late-running **Post Time** (Frosted) rounded out the minor placings.

Mystik Dan becomes the first Derby winner to subsequently win a race beneath the Twin Spires since Silver Charm backed up his win in the 1997 Run for the Roses in the GI Clark Handicap in 1998.

"When Mystik Dan is right, he's such a fun horse to ride because he makes my job so easy," Hernandez, Jr. said. "Just like in the Derby, today he sits in a nice pocket and let's you read the race. When you call on him, you know he's going to jump forward and that's what he did today. We got that spot turning for home and he showed why he won the Kentucky Derby in the past. It's a testament to the horse. He makes these kind of trips easy, I just have to point him in the right direction."

McPeek indicated that Mystik Dan would more than likely represent the stable in the GI Stephen Foster Stakes, a 'Win and You're In' qualified for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic on June 28.



### **Pedigree Notes:**

Bred on a similar cross to Grade III winner Mr. Money and on a variant of the cross that produced GISW and champion Wonder Wheel and GI La Troienne Stakes heroine Played Hard, Mystik Dan is one of now two winners from two to race out of Ma'am, whose 3-year-old daughter Yes Ma'am (Unified) won her maiden by 3 1/2 lengths at Horseshoe Indianapolis--ironically enough--on Kentucky Derby day four weeks ago.

Second dam Lady Siphonica, dam of the Hong Kong stakesplaced Renaissance Art (More Than Ready), was a full-sister to Siphonic, winner of the 2001 GI Hollywood Futurity and a halfsister to SW Mountain Girl (Mountain Cat). Also appearing under the third dam are GISW Laragh (Tapit) and MGSW & MGISP Summer Front (War Front).

Ma'am, who was bought back on a bid of \$2.9 million in foal to Into Mischief at last year's Fasig-Tipton November Sale, is also the dam of the 2-year-old filly Ford's Ma'am (Knicks Go) and the yearling colt Mystik Bayou (Wells Bayou).

He did little to dispel that notion when racing clear by 7 1/2 lengths in the GIII Robert B. Lewis Stakes on seasonal debut last February, but ultimately missed the Classics and the balance of the season. He made his return to the races in a red-hot renewal of the GI Churchill Downs Stakes May 3, his late run falling just short of fellow 'Rising Star' Mindframe (Constitution) while dead-heating for the place spot with Banishing (Ghostzapper).

"Juan rode him beautifully, the horse broke really well and he kept him up there," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "We are talking about a four-horse field, it is tough because you know you are going to be a big target there. He just inched him up there and he didn't lose his spot and once he took the lead, you figured out the horse that he is.

"I am so proud to have a horse like this. He is so talented, I know the Met Mile would have been a great spot, but his last race, you know he needed it. Now from here we can build and pick our spots. Eventually on to the Breeders' Cup. The way he handled it today, he didn't take a deep breath."

# **Pedigree Notes:**

On behalf of Clinton and Susie Atkins, Hall of Famer D. Wayne Lukas gave \$260,000 for Nysos's second dam Seresa's Spirit at the 2004 Keeneland September Sale when offered as part of the Estate of Better Devenport, whose husband Roger campaigned third dam Unbridled Elaine to victory in the 2001 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. Betty Devenport's passing on Jan. 21,2004 came just 22 days after her husband's.

Zetta Z was the first of three foals produced for the Atkinses by Seresa's Spirit before they sold her on for \$23,000 in foal to Curlin at Keeneland November in 2014. After producing six foals, including \$700,000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling Bandon Woods (Uncle Mo), Zetta Z fetched \$35,000 when offered pregnant to Street Sense at KEENOV in 2021 and the colt that would become Nysos followed her into the ring, changing hands for \$130,000. He would then sell for \$150,000 at Fasig-Tipton October in 2022 and for \$550,000 at OBS the following April.

It is safe to say that since then, the family has taken off. Zetta Z's foal of 2020, the Distorted Humor filly Attabe, was third in the Ruling Angel Stakes in May 2023 a handful of months before Nysos began making headlines. Attabe was represented by her first foal this season, a colt by Nyquist, bred in Kentucky by Mark Dodson. Warnock (Yaupon), the current 2-year-old out of Zetta Z, was a \$450,000 KEENOV purchase not long after Nysos broke his maiden and the circle was completed when Zetta Z was purchased by Coolmore for a sales-topping \$2 million in foal to Cyberknife at the 2024 Fasig-Tipton February Sale. Zetta Z was most recently covered by Justify. Cont. p6



Carl Pollard's Caressing returned a cool \$96 to her backers when taking out the 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and some 25 years later beneath the same Twin Spires, her 5-year-old son Mercante did the family proud with a gutsy victory in the GIII Arlington Stakes.

Silent Heart (Heart to Heart) won the break, but was in no particular hurry to lead them up, and with nothing else showing any initiative, favored Brilliant Berti was clicked up by Brian Hernandez, Jr. and slowed them down up front as Mercante refused to allow that one to get too far away from second. Lobbing them along at an even clip down the back, Brilliant Berti continued to hold the advantage, but had Mercante breathing down his neck and the two were more or less on even terms at the quarter pole. Mercante raced on his incorrect lead, but poked his head in front approaching the eighth pole and Brilliant Berti boxed on gamely, refusing to give way. The duo raced heads apart into the final sixteenth of a mile and Mercante gutted it out for the win. **Cont. p8**

### Arlington S. cont.

**Call Protection** (Good Samaritan), well-backed at 3-1, was pulled up and out of the race at the halfway stage by Irad Ortiz, Jr. and was vanned off. According to track publicity, the extent of the injuries to his right front leg were severe and the 4-year-old colt was euthanized.

A maiden winner in six starts for the Bill Mott barn--on turf debut in April 2023--Mercante won three of his four starts over the winter at Turfway Park, capping that streak with a breakthrough graded success in the GIII Kentucky Cup Classic Mar. 22. Returned to the grass for the GI Old Forester Turf Classic May 3, the homebred gelding was prominent every step of the way, had his head in front with a furlong to come and held very gamely to be second, beaten 3/4 of a length by Spirit of St Louis (Medaglia d'Oro).

# **Pedigree Notes:**

The Eclipse Award-winning 2-year-old filly of her generation in 2000, Caressing won the GIII La Troienne Stakes back at Churchill in 2001 and was Grade III-placed at four before calling it a career.

Her first five live foals won a total of six races before her 2011 produce, Gold Hawk became her first black-type horse with a third-place effort in the 2014 GIII Lecomte Stakes. The Grade III-placed Juan and Bina followed, but it was Gary and Mary West's West Coast who put the mare on the map, with victories in the 2017 GI Travers Stakes and GI Pennsylvania Derby en route to the 3-year-old championship. Caressing passed away in 2021 and Mercante is her final foal.

The family has also gained a foothold in Japan owing to Caressing's very first foal, My Goodness (Storm Cat), a \$475,000 Keeneland September yearling, but sold to Japanese interests for \$60,000 in foal to Purge at Keeneland November in 2010. My Goodness is responsible for seven winners from nine Japanese

starters, including G1 Yasuda Kinen upsetter and Classic-placed Danon Kingly (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}), Group 3 winner Danon Legend (Macho Uno) and the listed-winning Danon Good (Jpn) (Elusive Quality).

Royal Spa snapped a seven-race losing streak with a last-out win of Laurel's one-turn mile Heavenly Cause S. Apr. 12 and doubled up for a career high in Saturday's GIII Shawnee S. at Churchill Downs.

Off at odds of 13-1 here, she ran into a little trouble in the early going and was steadied slightly on the clubhouse turn. She raced in seventh through a half mile in :47.06, began to roll with a sweeping move on the far turn and came charging down the center to power past Gin Gin.

"This win means so much to me because (owner) Breffni Farm are some of the best people," said winning trainer Rodolphe Brisset. "We knew that probably going seven-eighths or a mile is her best distance but the circumstances really worked out well to try longer today. She was a bit further back than we originally planned but it might've benefitted her for the future. I'm not sure what we will do with her next. It worked out well trying a longer distance today but we also know she runs well going a little shorter." **Cont. p9** 



# **MERCANTE** Shows His Class at Churchill

Market leaders Skelly (Practical Joke) and 'TDN Rising Star' World Record went at each other hammer and tongs through unsustainable early fractions, and that set things up nicely for Durante, who came after the top two anew in upper stretch and inched away to register a 33-1 upset in Saturday's GIII Aristides Stakes at Churchill Downs.

The odds-on pop off consecutive big-figure stakes scores at his winter base at Oaklawn Park, Skelly missed the break--as he did when runner-up as the 3-10 chalk in last year's Aristides--and Durante was quickest away, cutting out the running through the opening stages before taking back into third when the top two choices hooked up approaching the turn.

The opening quarter-mile was posted in a wicked :20.94, but Skelly and World Record continued to match motors on the turn and led the field, racing noses apart, into the lane. World Record forged to a narrow advantage entering the final furlong, but Durante, who switched off the fence in upper stretch, began to reel him in and went on to prevail. Giant Mischief and Happy Is a Choice dead-heated for third, while Skelly finished a tailed-off last.

"He broke like a rocket but I was able to give him a breather around the turn," commented winning jockey Jose Ortiz. "In the stretch, he came on again and really finished up well. I think it was a really good field today and could beat one another on any given day. Today, it was our day."

# KING'S PLATE WINNER CAITLINHERGRTNESS RETURNS IN STYLE AT WOODBINE

Unraced since November, last year's King's Plate winner and Canadian champion 3-year-old filly Caitlinhergrtness (Omaha Beach) returned in great style to Woodbine Saturday, winning the GIII Belle Mahone Stakes to open her 2025 season.

Having beaten the boys in the first leg of the Canadian Triple Crown, the filly, named for WNBA player Caitlin Clark, returned to facing her own gender Saturday having been third behind She Feels Pretty (Karakontie {Jpn}) in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup Stakes at Keeneland and fourth in the GIII Maple Leaf to finish out her 2024 campaign.

Well rested off the six-month layoff and smoothly handled along the inside with a smooth beginning, Caitlinhergrtness settled a cozy third around the clubhouse turn as Dana's Beauty (Not This Time) dueled outside of For Flying (Brz) (Drosselmeyer) for command up front. Racing a solo third for much of the backstretch run, she was patiently handled even as the field began to swarm around her past the half-mile pole. Just awaiting her cue, the 2-1 race favorite got cut loose between horses with a quarter-mile left to run and, once in the clear, she ran up the score with a strong performance over For Flying who best Ready for Shirl (More Than Ready) in a three-way photo finish for the minor placings.

"I was just trying to get her to relax," said winning rider Rafael Hernandez. "She's been working really hard, and I just want to get her back on her feet and relax good. And I know when she is able to do that, when I put her in the clear, she's going to explode like she did today. She's been working amazing, and everything paid off today."

Trainer Kevin Attard added: "I was a little more nervous with her, just because she had been working so fast, and we were making a conscious effort trying to slow her down in the mornings. She came into us early in the year from WinStar, just looking like a different animal. She matured so much, she filled out, she grew and, you know, it all transpired onto the racetrack."

# **Pedigree Notes:**

One of 17 stakes winners and the 5th individual graded stakes winner for Omaha Beach, Caitlinhergrtness is out of a Giant's Causeway first dam with a perfect three for three record of runners to winners to her name. As a broodmare sire, Giant's Causeway needs no introduction, siring the dams of champions like Gun Runner (Candy Ride (Arg)). Belatrix, who passed through the KEENOV ring on a final bid of \$11,000 in 2023 before her daughter came to 'greatness', is a half-sister to MSW/GISP Dogtag (War Front) and to the dam of Australian MGSW/MG1SP Osipenko (NZ) (Pierro {Aus}). This is also the family of European champion 2-year-old colt and successful sire Shamardal (Giant's Causeway). Caitlinhergrtness has just one younger sibling-a 3-year-old Midnight Lute half-brother named Sovereign Star who is unraced. Belatrix was reported as served by Loggins for 2025 but has not produced a foal since 2022 despite visits to Cloud Computing for 2023 and Greatest Honour for 2024.

Old Chestnut took home the first graded trophy of his career when the 8-year-old won the GIII Jacques Cartier Stakes at Woodbine on Saturday.

The gelding was competing throughout his latest form cycle against optional claimers both at Woodbine last fall and through the spring at Gulfstream Park with little success. Entered in this particular race over the past two years with a third-place finish in 2023 and as the runner-up in 2024, Old Chestnut was

expecting to face Canadian Horse of the Year Patches O'Houlihan (Reload), but the champ was forced to scratch.

With only two others drawn, Old Chestnut was keen up the backstretch and dished out the tempo around the far turn. The veteran runner was roused to offer more by the top of the lane and he responded with a gate to wire performance.

"It was something you didn't expect," said trainer Martin Drexler, of Patches O'Houlihan's absence. "But, I mean, horse racing always throws something at you, so glad to take it. So, I actually thought we were live in here."

by FanDuel TV. It was bombs away in the GIII Royal North Stakes Saturday at Woodbine as the longest shot on the board, 70-1 chance Ms. Tart, blew past the field in the final strides to claim her first

graded stakes victory for Nathan McCauley and trainer Kevin Rice, who also celebrated a first graded stakes win.

A debut winner from Colonial Downs back in 2023, the daughter of Maximus Mischief was immediately tossed into deep waters and sank to 12th behind the classy MGISW She Feels Pretty (Karakontie (Jpn)) in the GI Natalma Stakes. Faring no better as a 3-year-old, she finished the year with no better result in a third sprinting 5 1/2 furlongs at Ellis Park in the Pea Patch Stakes before bouncing around barns in and out of the claiming ranks. Picked up for just \$35,000 by Kevin Rice in her first start at Gulfstream Jan. 18 of this year, Ms. Tart as found a string of good form in Florida, putting up back to back wins on the Tapeta and most recently finishing a good third behind 'TDN Rising Star' Earhart (Siyouni (Fr)) in the GIII Whimsical Stakes over the same distance May 3.

Facing that foe again Saturday but at woefully long odds and back on the grass for the first time since the Pea Patch, Ms. Tart was outrun by much of the line in the opening jumps and relegated to near last as Toupie (Uncle Mo) set the tempo inside of Dancing Duchess (Munnings) and Earhart furthest out. Still next to last midway around the sweeping turn, Ms. Tart hit the top of the stretch widest of the field but found plenty of momentum down the center of the Woodbine turf course and kept coming, just getting by 12-1 shot Ready to Jam in the final strides to top a monster trifecta with 39-1 shot Ticker Tape Home winning the photo for the show slot.

"It's amazing," said Rice. "It's my first graded stakes win, and it was just exciting watching, because, you know, going the gate, we're 40-something to one, and I'm not sure how we're going to do here, you know, full field and trying the turf here, but it was just amazing."

## **Pedigree Notes:**

The 12th stakes winner for Maximus Mischief, Ms. Tart is out of a winning Lemon Drop Kid mare who has now produced three stakes runners including James W. Murphy Stakes winner T D Dance (Can the Man) and GIII Twin Spires Turf Sprint Stakes runner-up Kid Perfect (Majesticperfection) from six to race. Ms. Tart last went through the ring as a short yearling, fetching \$145,000 at KEEJAN in 2022 for the partnership of Cash Is King and Commonwealth New Era Racing. Sheza Sweet Lemon has a yearling Corniche colt and was served by City of Light for this season.



Leaving the four hole on this unveiling as the most expensive auction buy in the race, **CANNONEER** (Into Mischief) will be carrying the colors of the partnership of St Elias and Stonestreet Stables. A \$1.75-million purchase last year at KEESEP, the son of top sire Into Mischief claims a fleet of accomplished half-siblings, most notable being the late GSW & MGISP Midnight Bourbon (Tiznow) and sire GISW Girvin (Tale of Ekati). Also in dam Catch the Moon (Malibu Moon)'s family portrait is GSW Cocked and Loaded (Colonel John) and GSW Pirate's Punch (Shanghai Bobby). One of said mare's full-sisters is Clarendon Fancy, herself the mother of GISW Brightwork (Outwork) and GSP Just as Fancy (Volatile). A half-sister to that pair produced GSP As Catch Can (Mo Town). Cannoneer is trained by Brad Cox and will have Florent Geroux in the irons as the morning line lists him at 2-1 odds.

To that one's outside is **Macchiato** (Gun Runner), the Winchell Thoroughbreds homebred who hails from the immediate female family of champion 3-year-old filly MGISW Untapable (Tapit) and her half-brother GISW Paddy O'Prado (El Prado {Ire}). A full-sister to the GI Kentucky Oaks victress is Red House, dam of MGSW Red Route One (Gun Runner) and his full-brother MSW & MGSP Red Run. Steve Asmussen trains this one.

**Password** (Uncle Mo) will break from the rail for owner/breeder Peter Blum and trainer Rodolphe Brisset. The colt's dam is a half-sister to several black-type winners and black-type producers, including Initiation (Deputy Minister), who

# OPINIONS DIVIDED ON WINDSOR CASTLE CHANGES

Leading Trainer Karl Burke Says Move Is 'Ridiculous'

Karl Burke, who has sent out more Royal Ascot-winning two-year-olds in the last decade than every other trainer bar Aidan O'Brien, has emerged as a fierce opponent to planned changes to the Windsor Castle Stakes, describing the new race conditions announced by the British Horseracing Authority's Flat Pattern Committee (FPC) as a "ridiculous idea".

In a press release issued by the FPC on Tuesday, it was revealed that the distance of the Windsor Castle will be increased to six furlongs from 2026. In addition, the Listed contest will be restricted to juveniles whose sire won at least once over seven furlongs plus at two, or a mile plus at three and above.

According to the FPC, these recommendations are part of a wider effort, in conjunction with the European Pattern Committee (EPC), to strengthen the middle-distance and staying horse divisions, and to broaden the appeal of sires beyond those predominately aimed at producing precocious speed.

Burke, however, believes that the new-look Windsor Castle will simply prove low-hanging fruit for the major owner-breeder operations with a monopoly on the best progeny of the top middle-distance stallions. **Cont. p3**

"We've got that many quangos trying to make racing for everybody, but the only people going to benefit from this are Coolmore and Ballydoyle and Darley and Godolphin, so far as I can see," Burke told the *TDN* after learning of the proposed changes. "The Windsor Castle has always been a race where the average man in the street has got a chance of buying a relatively cheap horse and having a runner at Royal Ascot. This is going to take that away from them.

"I'd say, nine times out of ten, the conditions of the race that they're suggesting will see a Ballydoyle horse at 6/4, a Godolphin horse at 2/1, and then it will be 10/1 bar. To me it just smacks of elitism and I don't know who thinks that this is going to promote the breeding of staying horses. I thought it was a ridiculous idea. It will be a crying shame if it goes through and I think it will be to the detriment of a lot of people."

Journalist and broadcaster Lydia Hislop is the chair of the FPC, with Burke's fellow trainers William Haggas and Simon Crisford also featuring among its 11 members. Hislop was contacted by the *TDN* on Friday and strongly refuted the suggestion that the changes recommended by the FPC were in any way "elitist".

"The idea that it's elitist, I think that's looking at it through a very narrow end of the telescope," she said. "I understand that

people who have commercial irons in the fire might feel that this is not a positive thing, but we're trying to ensure the diversity of the breed and that the supply of horses fits the race programme in the longer term, which couldn't be a more democratic argument.

"If we think about what people want to watch and how our sport is funded, via betting but also via TV coverage and attendances, people wish to see a diverse and competitive sport. At the moment, the supply chain is not delivering what the sport needs it to deliver, in order for it to carry on in that way.

"So, we can either be ruled by sectional, short-term interests, which I fear have often won the argument over the past 10 or 15 years. Or we can think about the long-term future of the sport, and I think that's what this decision is being made for."

Expanding on the rationale behind the changes, Hislop added, "At the moment, there appears to be a bias towards precocious speed. We're conscious that Royal Ascot already offers many opportunities for that. There is still the Queen Mary at five furlongs, there is still the Norfolk at five furlongs. It seemed that there was perhaps an over-emphasis and that these races were creating a sort of self-fulfilling prophecy."

"The concern is that there are a lot of horses being bred for a two-year-old target in June," Hislop continued. "If you have a disproportionate number of horses being bred for that target, then I don't think that is good for the long-term health of the breed--it certainly isn't good for the short-term health of the British racing industry."

It will likely be many years before we know whether these changes have been successful in their aims but, make no mistake, the fields assembled for future editions of the Windsor Castle will immediately look unrecognisable compared to those we've come to know since it was first awarded Listed status in 2004.

Last year, for example, only four of the 27 runners would have been able to eligible to run had the new race conditions already been in place. It would have been 4/23 in 2023 and 5/24 the previous year. All told, six of the last 10 winners would have needed to look elsewhere for a run at Royal Ascot.

Neither Little Big Bear nor Big Evs, two of the best winners of the Windsor Castle in recent times, would have qualified which, in hindsight, might have been for the betterment of the Norfolk. Big Evs, for example, ran to a BHA performance figure of 111 when winning the Windsor Castle in 2023, whereas Norfolk hero Valiant Force came away from the meeting with a Group 2 success on his CV despite running to a figure of just 108.

No Nay Never, the sire of Little Big Bear, and Blue Point, who produced Big Evs from his very first crop, were both winners at the meeting themselves, but at shorter trips than the new conditions demand.

And they're just two of the big-name stallions who will have one less chance to sire a Royal Ascot winner in years to come. When you throw into that mix other active stallions such as Dark Angel, Mehmas, Kodiac, Havana Grey, Showcasing and Ardad,

then it's a safe bet that a few powerful stud farm owners out there didn't welcome the news with open arms, either.

"It's disappointing from my point of view," confirmed Simon Sweeting of Overbury Stud, home to the 2016 Windsor Castle winner in Ardad. "Whilst I completely understand that they want to try and encourage the breeding of more middle-distance horses, you can't just forget about the more precocious, commercial type of stallion.

"This will obviously rule them out [of having runners in the Windsor Castle] and I think it would be a mistake to do that in one fell swoop. I don't think you can make a rapid change and I don't think it's going to have a particularly beneficial effect, as quickly as people might want it to."

Referencing the insatiable appetite of owners on the hunt for juveniles capable of running at Royal Ascot, he added, "It is a quick way to have success at the Royal meeting, which is what most owners aspire to and is a very, very important factor. If people can come in, buy a horse and taste success--or just enjoy the pleasure of being at Royal Ascot--then that in itself could lead to people getting more involved going forward, including with the middle-distance type of horse.

"I understand the reasons for the changes but, when you're standing stallions, there's no point trying to sell people pears when they want to buy apples."

Those sentiments were echoed by Burke, who provided some insight into the pressures faced by modern-day trainers when it comes to recruiting Royal Ascot juveniles for their owners.

"I would say 70-80% of the owners who we buy yearlings for are asking us to look for a precocious two-year-old that has a chance of going to Ascot," he explained. **Cont. p5**

"That will be the case when we go to the Premier Sale at Goffs, the Somerville Sale at Tattersalls or the September Sale at Tattersalls Ireland. We know that 90% of them don't make it, but there are a lot of horses bought at those sales I've just mentioned, specifically for an Ascot runner," he added.

Burke has saddled five two-year-old winners at Royal Ascot since 2020 alone, from Dandalla winning the Albany Stakes five years ago to a double in 2024 courtesy of Queen Mary heroine Leovanni and Norfolk scorer Shareholder. Dandalla was a relatively cheap buy at €22,000 from the September Yearling Sale, whereas Shareholder struck at Royal Ascot little more than a month after being bought for €460,000 at the Arqana Breeze-up Sale.

The Middleham trainer has certainly delivered on the brief for his owners, be their budget big or small, but the obsession with five days in June that Burke and his colleagues are having to accommodate leaves Hislop with questions.

"If that percentage of owners want a precocious two-year-old, what happens to that two-year-old in July? And August? And September? And when it's a thee-year-old or four-year-old?" she asked. "I think on the [Nick Luck Daily] podcast, Nick spoke with Jane Mangan and the view was that the horse is for life, not just for Royal Ascot as a two-year-old.

"I think the industry needs to step back and look at that as a business model and ask itself, 'Is that sustainable?'. And do we think this is a position that British racing can be proud of?"

It was also suggested by the eponymous host on Wednesday's Nick Luck Daily that exceptions could be made for the likes of Blue Point, advocating even a possible tweak to the conditions which would allow runners by stallions who won a Group 1 at the age of three or above. Cont. p6

Burke, too, was said to be incredulous when he learned of the identity of some of the elite sires whose progeny would be barred from the start line for the Windsor Castle from next year.

Hislop concedes that a horse like Blue Point might have been somewhat caught in the crossfire of these changes. The Kildangan Stud resident who completed a memorable Group 1 sprint double at Royal Ascot aged five is far from the flash-bang two-year-old type that has saturated the stallion market in recent years, many would argue to the detriment of the breed.

It's worth remembering, however, the extent to which stallions of Blue Point's ilk will still be catered for at Royal Ascot, a fixture where nearly 30% (10/35) of the races are run over six furlongs or less.

"I thought that was a very interesting suggestion, although I'd imagine some might say that that was an even more elitist way of going about it," Hislop said of Luck's compromise. "I agree that it is a shame that the progeny of a horse such as Blue Point, who was a proper top-class sprinter, might not be eligible for the Windsor Castle. But there is still the Coventry, there is still the Queen Mary, there is still the Albany, and there is still the Norfolk.

"There are opportunities for two-year-olds and, almost more importantly for the long-term health of the breed, there is also

the Commonwealth Cup, there is also the King Charles III, and there is also the Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee. There are many, many, many races at Royal Ascot for the likes of Blue Point's progeny to be running in--the Windsor Castle just won't be one of them."

She added, "I think it [the changes to the Windsor Castle] might help strengthen the Norfolk which has been under some pressure in recent years. I think there was almost too much of a crossover between the two races in the end and horses that you really felt ought to be running in the Norfolk were instead running in the Windsor Castle. So, I think that is potentially a big positive, ditto for the Queen Mary. It could help in that regard."

As for the older sprinters, it was only last year that the Group 1 status of the Commonwealth Cup was reported to be at risk, with Malton trainer Richard Fahey describing himself at the time as "hugely surprised" by the development. In 2022, he registered his second win in the race courtesy of Perfect Power, Ardad's first crop son who'd already won the Norfolk the previous year.

Consulted by the *TDN* about the changes to the Windsor Castle announced earlier this week, Fahey again expressed his concern with regards the apparent downward trajectory of the domestic sprinting scene.

"What's amazed me really is that in the past few years our sprinters seem to have gotten worse," he said. "Why aren't they trying to protect the sprinters as well? There was talk about changing the Commonwealth Cup from a Group 1 to a Group 2 last year. This won't help that situation but, look, it is only one race. It's not going to make a massive difference to me, but I'm sure a lot of people will disagree. As you get older, whatever they do you just carry on!"

Carry on we all will, no doubt, but those with the power to instigate genuine change cannot just bury their heads in the sand any longer, according to Hislop who, whilst agreeing with Fahey's comments about the sprinting scene, warned against conflating speed and precocity.

She also stressed that the Pattern Committees remain intent on strengthening the quality of the sprint division in Europe, with the upshot being that the likelihood of the Commonwealth Cup being downgraded in the near future is very low, even in the event that the annual and rolling three-yearly ratings dictate that the matter must be discussed by the EPC.

"For a good while now--probably for the same 20-odd years we've seen the staying division in slow decline--we've been breeding more precocious types, and yet we're not breeding

better sprinters," she asserted. "We made improvements to the sprint programme. The Commonwealth Cup was created out of nothing by the EPC as part of a coherent sprinting programme, an opportunity for three-year-old sprinters to have something to focus on. There are challenges, but you have to stick with it.

"Quite often in this conversation, precocity and sprinting can become conflated. They are not the same thing. We would like a thriving sprint programme, in the same way that we would like a thriving stayers' programme, but the Pattern Committees are only part of that equation. It also requires broader, industry-wide prioritisation and focus."

Of course, the plan for the Windsor Castle is not the only intervention we've seen brought in with the aim of safeguarding the production, retention and racing of quality horses with stamina in Europe. This population has been dwindling over a number of years, with an already threadbare programme being decimated further by the loss of talented stayers to different racing jurisdictions such as Australia.

The Pattern Committees first began work on the stayers' project in 2016, before generating a framework of pan-European upgrades to the staying Pattern programme the following year. As recently as February, the EPC announced a series of Group 1 upgrades in this area. Cont. p8

Hislop also highlighted the way the BHA Development Fund has been utilised in recent years. In 2025, over £3.3 million in prize-money will be available across 88 High-Value Developmental Races in Britain, with an increased focus on potential stayers.

"This is the thing we're really good at here, producing middle-distance horses and stayers," Hislop added of European racing's traditional strong suit. "Those pedigrees are so old and well developed. What they are is class, that's what they are. It's not just stamina. And we seem to be valuing that so cheaply that we're prepared to mortgage our future for the sake of some two-year-old races in June.

"I don't think that the sport can carry on just looking at that and thinking, somehow, it's all going to be fine, because it isn't."

"Sinileo won very easily, impressing Maxime Guyon," the owner-breeders' racing manager Pierre-Yves Bureau said. "He is in a large field and lacks experience, so we are a bit in the unknown. He showed very nice acceleration on his debut and

the race seems open, so we are taking our chance. As far as I can remember, supplementing one of ours for the Jockey Club is not a frequent occurrence."

#### Clarehaven And Ballydoyle Double-Handed

Also drawn favourably is the likely favourite **Camille Pissarro**, who goes up in trip having finished off so well in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains. That is a decision made more on jockey opinion than pedigree and it will be interesting to see if he can impose himself on a trio that finished just behind him at ParisLongchamp in **Luther**, **Ridari** and **Detain**. Camille Pissarro is in one, with his stablemate and possible pacemaker **Trinity College** handily-placed in three and it will be interesting to see if the latter, who is a useful colt in his own right, goes forward and if so what kind of test he presents to the others.

The Gosdens supply their own duo in the aforementioned Detain and **TDN Rising Star Bowmark**, with stalls six and eight respectively aiding their cause. Like Camille Pissarro, Detain is a Wootton Bassett but with a stouter pedigree while Kingman's Bowmark will appreciate moving up from a mile being from the family of Serpentine.

Thady Gosden said of the Clarehaven pair, "We had the Prix du Jockey Club in mind even before Detain's race in the Poule d'Essai des Poulains and he confirmed there that he will handle this trip. He's not a real stayer like Arrest, as he is by Wootton Bassett and thus has more speed and his preparation has gone well.

"Bowmark has not yet shown all his talent, but he won like a very good colt at York and William Buick who came to ride him in the morning told us he should handle this distance without any problem. It is very difficult to choose between our two runners--they have very different profiles."

#### **Downed By The Draw?**

In this race, when you go into double figures with the draw you are talking about a task made significantly harder regardless of talent. While New Bay, Intello and Lope De Vega overcame such a compromising post position in recent times, none have done so since 2015. Connections of Luther, who was fourth in the Poulains, will take heart from the fact that although Kieran Shoemark will have to navigate stall 13 here, that trio all came off a prominent showing in the ParisLongchamp Classic. A win for the same connections as the disqualified Pouliches winner Shes Perfect would be well-received and Luther is bred to love this trip at least.

Another certain to enjoy stretching out from a mile is Ridari, the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau winner who was a short neck and a head behind Camille Pissarro and Luther and a length in front of Detain in the Poulains. Mikel Delzangles is happy that the son of the G1 Prix de l'Opera heroine Ridasiyna can make his presence felt as one of the country's leading middle-distance colts. "The Poulains is a good trial for this and although they broke the track record he seems well and I think he has progressed again physically," he said.

"He produced a very nice finish there and was hampered a few metres from the post by the second which probably cost him fourth place or even third," he added. "He was a bit tense at two and we weren't sure about stepping him up in trip so quickly, but his behaviour is improving and I have no doubt that he will stay 2,100 metres. I also trained his dam and there are many similarities between them. They are horses with a lot of blood and physically they resemble each other a little."

"You cannot run in this race with a horse you don't feel is mature enough to compete," he concluded. "It's a race that can leave its mark. You should only run in it if you have a good chance with a colt fit enough to handle it, otherwise they need 12 months to recover! You need a 1,600-metre horse who can stay 2,100 metres and a very good 1,600-metre horse can handle 400 metres more without a problem."

Last seen winning Doncaster's Listed Gillies Fillies' Stakes in November, Cheveley Park Stud's Estrange was back with a bang in Saturday's G3 Lester Piggott Fillies' Stakes at Haydock. Confidently ridden by Danny Tudhope anchored in rear early, the 13-8 second favourite loomed on the outer approaching two out as if she had just joined in. Sent on soon after, the David O'Meara-trained daughter of Night Of Thunder responded with relish to record an emphatic 4 1/4-length success from the 11-8 market-leader Shaha.

Estrange has been entered in the Arc, which says a lot about the regard in which she is held, and O'Meara was not keen to pour cold water on the enthusiasm. "Potentially she could be the best we've had," he said.

"Danny said she's great to ride. She shuts down and saves energy, you can put her anywhere and give her a small squeeze and she comes alive. For me, for the yard, for everyone it is brilliant to have a horse like her," O'Meara continued.

"She handles cut in the ground, she's gone on good ground today. I think we'll stay away from quick conditions, but the [G1] Pretty Polly could be considered or there's a race back here, the [G2] Lancashire Oaks, and then the [G1] Yorkshire Oaks and if she is good enough it would be great to be considering Longchamp. It never looked in doubt at any stage today."

Estrange was a purchase by the Stud, a 425,000gns one at Tattersalls October Book 1 due to her dam Alienate being Oasis Dream's half-sister to the G1 St Leger hero Logician. Responsible also for Frankel's G2 Park Hill Stakes third Lmay and the Listed-placed Basalt by Pinatubo, the unraced Juddmonte cast-off is also kin to four other black-type performers including Champs Elysees's triple Graded-Stakes scorer and GI E. P. Taylor Stakes runner-up Suffused who is the dam of Sunday's unbeaten G3 Prix de Royaumont contender Sunly by Estrange's sire Night Of Thunder.

Alienate's full-sister Sleep Walk is responsible for Caravaggio's dual GI Diana Stakes heroine Whitebeam and another Frankel colt in Nightwalker who was third in the G3 Autumn Stakes and lines up in Saturday's Derby. This is the family of the smart sires Cityscape and Bated Breath, whose Oasis Dream-sired half-sister Tarentaise produced Equiano's G2 Meydan Sprint winner and G1 King's Stand Stakes runner-up Equilateral. Alienate's 2-year-old colt by Lope De Vega was a 62,000gns purchase by Andrew Oliver at the Tattersalls Somerville Yearling Sale.

"He was going too fast, but I saw no sense in fighting him and let him have his head," De Vries explained. "He started looking around on the turn, which gave him the chance for a breather and then he came back, fighting well in the straight." Alessandro Botti added, "He is still green and a big baby and the [G1 Deutsches] Derby is his target."

#### SCENIC PREVAILS IN THE BRONTE CUP

Still making her way in the staying category, David Ward's **Scenic** enjoyed her finest hour in Saturday's G3 Bronte Cup Fillies' Stakes at York. Successful in the Listed Galtres Stakes over a mile and a half here in August, the Ed Walker-trained mare had signed off last season with a fourth in Doncaster's G2 Park Hill Fillies' Stakes before returning to fill second spot behind Shaha in Goodwood's Listed Daisy Warwick Fillies' Stakes earlier in the month. Reserved in rear early by Saffie Osborne, the 7-2 second favourite was delivered to overhaul last year's winner **Term Of Endearment** close home and score by a head.

"She's just a really lovely, game horse and it's a big result," Walker said. "We've always had this race in mind and then we just snuck in the race at Goodwood first, the ground was right and we thought it might bring her forward. We couldn't get on grass much this spring, so there's improvement in her still. We'll probably come back for the Yorkshire Oaks. She loves it here and we've absolutely nothing to lose. We'll have a crack and then the Prix de Royallieu at the end of the year will be the big shot for her."

## TEN BOB TONY COMPLETES NIGHT OF THUNDER DOUBLE AT HAYDOCK

On another big afternoon for Night Of Thunder, **Ten Bob Tony** continued the good work begun by the exciting Estrange by completing a Group 3 double for the sire in Haydock's G3 John Of Gaunt Stakes. Also making it two in this category on the afternoon was the Ed Walker stable, following the win of Scenic at York, with TBT Racing's newly-gelded 4-year-old regaining the level he had hit when runner-up to the smart Topgear in ParisLongchamp's G3 Prix du Pin in September.

In front initially before the pace became too hot, the 5-1 shot was coaxed back to the lead by William Buick approaching the final furlong as the high-class veteran **Kinross** emerged.

Battling to ward off that Kingman flagbearer in the final yards, he eked out a career-best head success to complete a stellar week for the yard after the wins of Mgheera, Almaqam, Scenic and Balmoral Lady.

"Ten Bob Tony was Simon Sadler's first ever horse and he's now come into the game in quite a big way," Walker said. "He had his first stakes winner in Qilin Queen in a Listed race at Newbury on Lockinge day and then this first Group-race win. I've won Group Ones before, but I have to say this has been a special day and special week."

Walker, who was at York, was represented by his assistant Matty Hicks who said of the winner, "He's always gone well fresh, he was a bit head-scratching towards the end of last year but we always banked on his form in France with Topgear and he's shown it a couple of times since. Topgear looks a Group One winner in waiting, so we've always liked our horse. He's very tough and gelding him has made him a bit more of a man, he's getting towards being the finished article. I'd say he's more like to go back up to a mile than down to six furlongs and he has two entries at Ascot, the Hunt Cup and Queen Anne."

# OAKS FAVOURITE DESERT FLOWER FEATURES AMONG NINE CONFIRMATIONS

Following Saturday's confirmation stage, Godolphin's 1,000 Guineas heroine **Desert Flower** (Night Of Thunder) is one of nine possible runners in Friday's Betfred Oaks at Epsom. Unbeaten in five career starts, culminating with a comfortable defeat of

Flight and Simmering in the 1,000 Guineas at Newmarket, Desert Flower is the sponsor's 7/4 favourite to complete a Classic double at Epsom, a feat last achieved by the Aidan O'Brien-trained Love five years ago.

O'Brien is responsible for three of the remaining nine contenders in **Giselle** (Frankel), the wide-margin winner of the Listed Lingfield Oaks Trial, **Minnie Hauk** (Frankel), who won the Listed Cheshire Oaks on her most recent start, and the G3 Musidora Stakes scorer **Whirl** (Wootton Bassett).

Last seen finishing fourth behind Desert Flower when having just her second start in the 1,000 Guineas, the Saeed bin Suroor-trained **Elwateen** (Dubawi) was supplemented on Friday at a cost of £30,000. She will be the sole representative in the Classic for the Shadwell team who, as expected, have taken their Falakeyah out of the race.

Joseph O'Brien's **Wemightakedlongway** (Australia) could join the Ballydoyle contingent on the journey from Ireland, having won the G3 Salsabil Stakes at Navan on her most recent outing, while the possible field is completed by the one-two from the Listed Fillies' Trial Stakes at Newbury, **Qilin Queen** (Pinatubo) and **Revoir** (Study Of Man), and the Musidora third **Go Go Boots** (Night Of Thunder).

Meanwhile, eight horses remain in contention for the G1 Betfred Coronation Cup earlier on the card, headed by Francis-Henri Graffard's **Calandagan** (Gleneagles), whose last three starts have seen him fill the runner-up spot in a trio of top-level contests--the Juddmonte International, Champion Stakes and Dubai Sheema Classic.

St Leger hero Jan Brueghel (Frankel), Hong Kong Vase scorer Giavellotto (Mastercraftsman) and Irish Oaks winner You Got To Me (Nathaniel) all feature among his potential rivals.

First port of call must be the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, which has become so key to this Classic since it was stripped of true "Derby" status when cut from the traditional mile-and-a-half trip 20 years ago. **Camille Pissarro** fared best of the five who took part in the mile Classic and has what looks an ideal draw in one, especially given that his stablemate **Trinity College** is close by but he seemed to be suited by being wide there and when winning the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere and he will be right in the thick of the crowd from that post. **Ridari** was on the premises in the Poulains and while he has a double-figure draw, those that have overcome that in recent times include a trio who came from that ParisLongchamp Classic and his style of racing suggests it is not the end of the world. Given that the Wertheimers already had **Nitoi**, the winner of an established trial in the track's Listed Prix de Suresnes, it is significant that they have not only supplemented **Sinileo** but that Maxime Guyon picks him. So impressive on debut over a mile here, he takes a mighty leap but Guyon has told *Paris-Turf* that this is their best 3-year-old. One of the better unexposed 3-year-old colts around, **Bowmark** just looks like a surefire good horse waiting to happen and a win would provide the Gosdens with a second Classic in 2025 with a son of Kingman.
